


# SAN JUAN DIEGO PATHS

## A very Mexican Saint.

Know symbolic places of the indigenous saint life. We start visiting Cuatitlan, in Estado de Mexico state, where you can visit the sanctuary of "Santuario de la Siempre Virgen María de Guadalupe". This sanctuary was built where San Juan Diego was born and where he lived with his uncle Bernardino. We continue to Santa Maria Tulpetlac church. Here the fifth manifestation of Virgin of Guadalupe has occurred. After that, we continue to Teotihuacan, the most famous archeological site of this area and known as "place of the Gods". After the visit, return to Mexico City.

## THE BIGGEST SANCTUARY IN MEXICO

Our day begins visiting Santiago Tlatelolco church, built in a place where “Mexica” population resisted military more than 80 days against Spanish Conquistadores.

We continue to the most important sanctuary in Mexico and Latin America: Basílica de Nuestra Señora de Guadalupe, where every 12<sup>th</sup> December thousands of pilgrims go to commemorate the manifestation of Virgin Mary to San Juan Diego. After that, we return to the city center and we visit of the Metropolitan Cathedral, colonial treasure and place of the primary archdiocese of Mexico; here we can visit also the Archbishop’s vault (subject to approval of the authorities)

Admire the original “tilma” where the image of the Virgin of Guadalupe was staged.



Discover the religious, architectonic and artistic value of one of the most important worship center of the city and of Latin America.

## SAINT MICHEAL ARCHANGEL MANIFESTATION

San Miguel del Milagro is situated in Nativitas, a town in the state of Tlaxcala (nearby the archeological site of Cacatla). The catholic sanctuary of Saint Micheal Archangel is situated in this town, where the legend say that in 1631 the angel appeared. Every year pilgrims from all over the country go to the sanctuary to celebrate the three manifestations: 1<sup>st</sup> on April 25<sup>th</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> on May 8<sup>th</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> on Novembre 13<sup>th</sup>.

# SAINT MICHEAL ARCHANGEL

## 1ST DAY

Departure to Huejotzingo, in the state of Puebla; this little town is famous for an ex – convent very well conserved (declared UNESCO heritage site – closed on Monday)

We continue to the Sanctuary of Saint Micheal Archangel in the state of Tlaxcala. After the visit, continuation to Basílica de Ocotlán, one of the greatest example of the Mexican baroque.



## 2ND DAY

Visit of Cholula, where we can visit the famous church Nuestra Señora de los Remedios, built on the precolombian pyramid with the world's largest base.

After the visit, we continue to Santa María Tonantzitla. Its church is the maximum expression of the Mexican baroque. Continuation to Puebla and visit of the city.

## 1ST DAY

Arrival at Mexico City International Airport and transfer to the hotel.

## 2ND DAY

Visit of Santiago Tlatelolco Church, built by the Spanish conquistadores after they defeated the Mexica population

Continuation to the Sanctuary of the Virgin of Guadalupe, the most important sanctuary of Mexico and Latin America (here you can participate in a mass). Return to the center and visit of the Metropolitan Cathedral. Continuation with a walking tour in the city center.

## 3RD DAY

The day begins with the visit of the place known as the house of San Juan Diego, the sanctuary of Nuestra Siempre Virgen de Guadalupe. Continuation to Tlupetlac where the legend says that there was the fifth manifestation of the Virgin. Transfer to Teotihuacan, “the place of the Gods”, the most famous archeological site of this area. Return to Mexico City



## 4TH DAY

Visit of the southern part of Mexico City; San Angel neighborhood, Xochimilco, where we can have a tour on one of the traditional boat, Trajineras.

We finish the day with a walking tour in Coyoacan, one of the ancient neighborhoods of the city



## 5TH DAY

Transfer to the airport
